The Council of the City of Wetumpka held a work session prior to the 6:00 p.m. council meeting held on Monday, December 6, 2021. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jerry Willis at 6:04 p.m. Councilmember Robbins led the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilmember Brown.

Upon a Roll Call the following were present: Mayor Jerry Willis and Councilmembers Kevin Robbins, Cheryl Tucker, Lynnes Justiss, Steve Gantt and Joe Brown. Also present were City Clerk Tiffany Robinson and staff members.

Councilmember Justiss offered a motion to approve the minutes of the Council Meeting held on November 15, 2021 as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Brown with the Council voting unanimously in favor of the motion.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Councilmember Robbins made a motion to suspend the rules and move forward on voting on the purchase of 23 body cameras for the Police Department.
