The Council of the City of Wetumpka held a work session prior to the 6:00 p.m. council meeting held on Monday, November 15, 2021. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Jerry Willis at 6:05 p.m. Councilmember Robbins led the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Councilmember Brown.

Upon a Roll Call the following were present: Mayor Jerry Willis and Councilmembers Kevin Robbins, Cheryl Tucker, Lynnes Justiss, Steve Gantt and Joe Brown. Also present were City Clerk Tiffany Robinson and staff members.

Councilmember Justiss offered a motion to approve the minutes of the Council Meeting held on November 1, 2021 as presented. The motion was seconded by Councilmember Brown with the Council voting unanimously in favor of the motion.

Mayor Willis opened the public hearing for a 040-Retail Beer (on or off premises only) and 060-Retail Table Wine (on or off premises) for Four Macon, LLC located at 191 Spring Street, Wetumpka, AL. No one spoke in favor or against. The public hearing was closed.

There was no old business.

Under new business, Councilmember Gantt made a motion to approve 040-Retail Beer (on or off premises only) and 060-Retail Table Wine (on or off premises) for Four Macon, LLC located at 191 Spring Street, Wetumpka, AL. Councilmember Justiss seconded the motion with the Council voting unanimously in favor of the motion.

Councilmember Justiss made a motion to grant permission to advertise for a public hearing concerning a petition by the Wetumpka Planning Commission to amend certain

sections of the Zoning Ordinance of Wetumpka, AL concerning billboards. Councilmember Robbins seconded the motion with the Council voting unanimously in favor of the motion.

Ordinance 2021-____, an ordinance to amend sections of the Zoning Ordinance of Wetumpka, AL concerning billboards was read for the first time by the City Attorney.

Councilmember Robbins made a motion to grant permission to enter into agreement for professional services with Hydro Engineering Solutions for a hydrologic and hydraulic watershed model for the Gossum Switch Watershed. Councilmember Brown seconded the motion with the Council voting unanimously in favor of the motion.

Upon a motion by Councilmember Gantt, the meeting was adjourned at 6:14 p.m.
